Established over a decade ago in Denver, Colorado, this year marks High Noon's debut in *realscreen's* Global 100. The appearance is prompted by two shows that readers positively noted: TLC's *Cake Boss* (pictured) and VH1's *Tough Love*, coproduced with Drew Barrymore's Flower Films. But it's also proof of a particularly important year in the company's evolution — in 2009, VH1 greenlit a spin-off for *Tough Love*, the brand new *Tough Love Couples*, launching in April, and premiered a new docusoap, *Secrets of Aspen*, from the prodco. Known as a prolific supplier of programming for U.S. cabling throughout its history, this past year saw two High Noon productions — *Tough Love* and *Secrets of Aspen* — pick up international distribution through Shine International. Development deals with truTV and Animal Planet are bringing the company closer to CEO Jim Berger's goal, as stated in the May 2009 issue of *realscreen*: to have the range to produce for eight to 10 networks.
